RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR DESIGNATION OF  
U. S. ROUTE 15/20/231/22 AS AN "ALL AMERICAN ROAD"

RECITALS

The United States Congress approved legislation in May 2008 to create The Journey Through Hallowed Ground National Heritage Area.

This legislation creates a National Highway Area corridor that includes U.S. Routes 15/20/231/22 from Thomas Jefferson's Monticello in Charlottesville, Virginia north to Gettysburg, Pennsylvania.

Designation of the Journey Through Hallowed Ground as a National Heritage Area, and Route 15/20/231/22 as an All American Road within the National Scenic Byways Program, will help support the four-state public/private partnership that has been developed to promote and celebrate the historical and cultural resources along the route.

Designation as a National Heritage Area and All American Road will make federal funds available to government entities located along this corridor for the purposes of developing tourism, preservation and enhancement of historical sites and battlefields.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland supports the designation of the Journey Through Hallowed Ground Byway (Route 15/20/231/22) as an All American Road within the National Scenic Byways Program.

Adopted and effective this 4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2008.


