

RESOLUTION NO. RS-08-06
**WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF
VOLUNTEER FIRE OR RESCUE ORGANIZATIONS**

RECITALS

Md. Code, Labor & Employments Article, §9-234(w) provides that the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland may by resolution provide that, upon election, members of a volunteer fire or rescue company within Washington County may be considered covered employees while on duty for purposes of workers' compensation coverage provided by the county government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland, that:

1. Upon election by a volunteer fire or rescue company in Washington County as defined by Md. Code, Labor & Employments Article, §9-234(a)(3) that its members be considered covered employees, members of said company shall be considered covered employees while on duty as defined by Md. Code, Labor & Employments Article, §9-234(a)(2) for purposes of workers' compensation coverage provided by the county government.

2. All definitions, restrictions, and regulations contained in Md. Code, Labor & Employments Article, §9-234, as amended from time to time, shall apply to the covered employee, the insurance coverage provided, and all claim procedures and determinations.

3. This Resolution does not and shall not convey or imply any other rights or privileges of employment except for workers' compensation coverage as indicated in Md. Code, Labor & Employments Article, §9-234, as amended from time to time.


