

**INVITATION TO BID****PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE & REHABILITATION PROGRAM FY-'11****CHIP SEAL APPLICATIONS****CONTRACT NO. MS-PMP-143-28****PROJECT NO. 28-143**

The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland, will accept sealed bids for the **Pavement Maintenance & Rehabilitation Program FY-'11, Chip Seal Applications, Contract No. MS-PMP-143-28.** Bids will be received and time-stamped in the **Division of Public Works – Department of Capital Projects**, County Administrative Annex, 80 West Baltimore Street, Hagerstown, MD 21740-6003, until **2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 23, 2010.** After which time they will be publicly opened in a conference room of the County Administrative Annex. Bids received after this time will be returned unopened.

The **Pavement Maintenance & Rehabilitation Program FY-'11, Chip Seal Applications** project work is generally described as **Double Chip Seal Surface Treatment, Chip Seal Bar Patch, and Pavement Paint Marking Lines, Legends and Symbols.** All work on this project shall be done in accordance with the MSHA Specifications.

Qualified Contractors may obtain plans and specifications from the **Division of Public Works – Department of Capital Projects**, County Administrative Annex, 80 West Baltimore Street, Hagerstown, MD 21740-6003, **between 7:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. until 4:30 p.m.,** (Telephone 240-313-2400), upon a **NON-REFUNDABLE fee of Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00)** for each complete set. For mail requests, which must be made in writing, an additional **Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)** per set must be included, along with a full mailing address, contact person with e-mail address, and phone / fax number. All checks for bidding documents shall be made payable to the **Washington County Treasurer.** If a Contractor wishes to supply a FedEx or UPS account number in lieu of the additional mailing fee, this is acceptable. Payment must be received before bid documents can be mailed.

Bid security in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid amount shall be submitted with Contractor's bid. Bid bonds shall be made payable to the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Maryland. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Payment and Performance Bonds for the full amount of the Contract. Bids shall be executed on bid forms provided with the bidding documents in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

The County may make such investigations as he deems necessary to determine the ability of the Bidder to perform the work, and prospective Bidders shall be required to furnish to the County's representative all such information as may be requested. The County reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such Bidder fails to satisfy the County that such Bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligation of the Contract and to complete

the work contemplated therein.

A Pre-Bid Conference for the project will be held **Tuesday, June 1, 2010 at 11:00 a.m.** local time in a conference room at the **Division of Public Works – Department of Capital Projects, County Administrative Annex, 80 West Baltimore Street, Hagerstown, MD.** All prospective Bidders are encouraged to attend.

Washington County shall make positive efforts to utilize Disadvantaged Business Enterprises for its supplies and services and shall allow these sources the maximum feasible opportunity to compete for contracts. The Board of County Commissioners does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age and disability in employment or the provision of services.
